Thank you for your interest in the North Carolina Spot Festival Princess Pageant. The pageant will be held on Saturday, September 24, 2011 in Hampstead, NC at South Topsail Elementary School.

Attached is the official application and rules/regulations. **Make sure you read the rules/regulations carefully, as there have been some changes add to the rules.** The deadline for entry is September 2, 2011.

Our first rehearsal/meeting will be Saturday, September 10, 2011 at 11:00 AM. Pictures (headshots only) will be taken at this meeting. These pictures will be used for the program book and newspapers.

Final rehearsal will be Friday, September 23, 2011 at 6:15 PM. We will have a pizza party before beginning rehearsal of entire pageant (talent must be preformed as you will for the pageant). This will not be a dress rehearsal.

All rehearsals will be held at South Topsail Elementary School on Hoover Road in Hampstead

Again this year, we will have a luncheon on Saturday, September 24, 2011. The location of the luncheon will be announced later. All judges will be at the luncheon with contestants. This is a chance for them to get to know the girls outside of the interview portion of the pageant. Competition for the pageant includes interview, talent, and evening gown. During the evening gown portion, the contestant will be asked to give a 30 – 35 second poem about the Spot Fish (This will be a spoken poem. There will be no props, singing, etc.). The opening number wardrobe will be a black dress and black shoes.

Princess Pageant Rules and Regulations

Contestants, family members, and chaperones will conduct themselves in a proper manner. Entrant agrees with the time, manner, and method of judging and that the decision of the judges is **final**.

Entrant's age shall not be less than nine or more than twelve on the date of the pageant.

Entrant must perform a talent routine within the **3 minute time limit**. Overtime will result in disqualification.

Music must be on a **clean CD, cued and ready to start**. If contestant is performing on an instrument, she must furnish her own instrument and play live, no pre-taped performance is allowed.

Contestants must furnish their own talent props. No hazardous props will be allowed (example, fire baton). All props must be approved prior to the final rehearsal by the director.

No two contestants may use the same music. Music will be honored on a first-come-first served basis, beginning at the time application with paid entry fee is received.

Only **ONE** adult chaperone may accompany the contestants at rehearsals. Please, no siblings or other family members.

Only **ONE ADULT FEMALE DRESSER** will be permitted in the dressing room on the night of the pageant. The dresser will have to stay backstage. **NO PARENT WILL BE ALLOWED AS A DRESSER OR PERMITTED BACKSTAGE, EVEN AT INTERMISSION.**

If entrant is currently holding a title, title must be immediately relinquished in writing signed by contestant, parent, and pageant director along with the application by August 24, 2011.

Winner of the pageant cannot accept or compete for another title until her Spot Festival crown has been relinquished.

If, for any reason, the winner cannot fulfill her obligation as the North Carolina Spot Festival Princess, she must relinquish her crown, all prizes, and awards to the first runner-up.

The winner will be expected to attend designated functions during her reign which will be noted in the contract. The contract must be signed by winner and parent/guardian on Sunday, September 25, 2011. All other appearances must be approved by the North Carolina Spot Festival Princess Business Manager.

The contestant understands and agrees that the NC Sport Festival Pageant Committee is not responsible for personal injuries or loss of personal property during the rehearsal periods and the weekend of the pageant.

Failure to comply with these rules and regulations will result in disqualification from this pageant or loss of crown.
